appointment



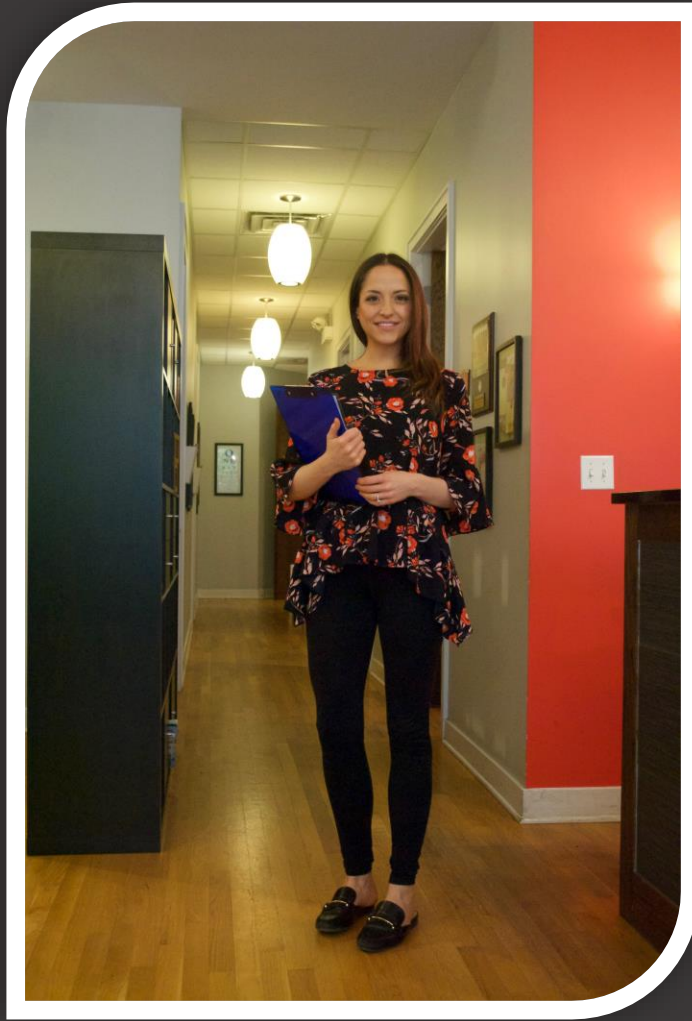


You will sit in the waiting room until your name is called

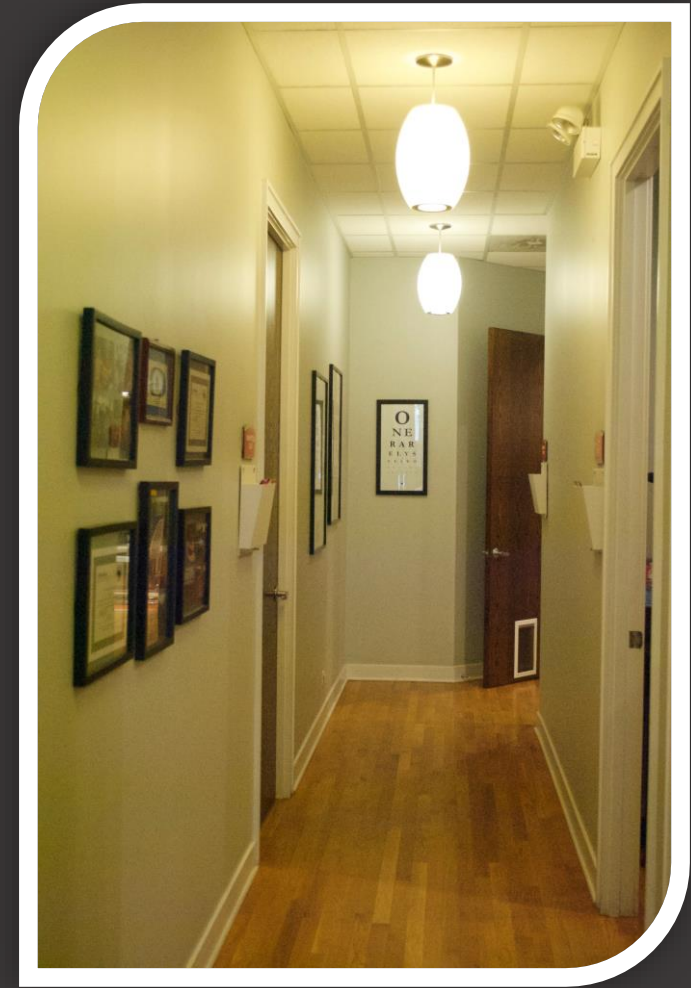


You can play, color or read in the kids area while you wait





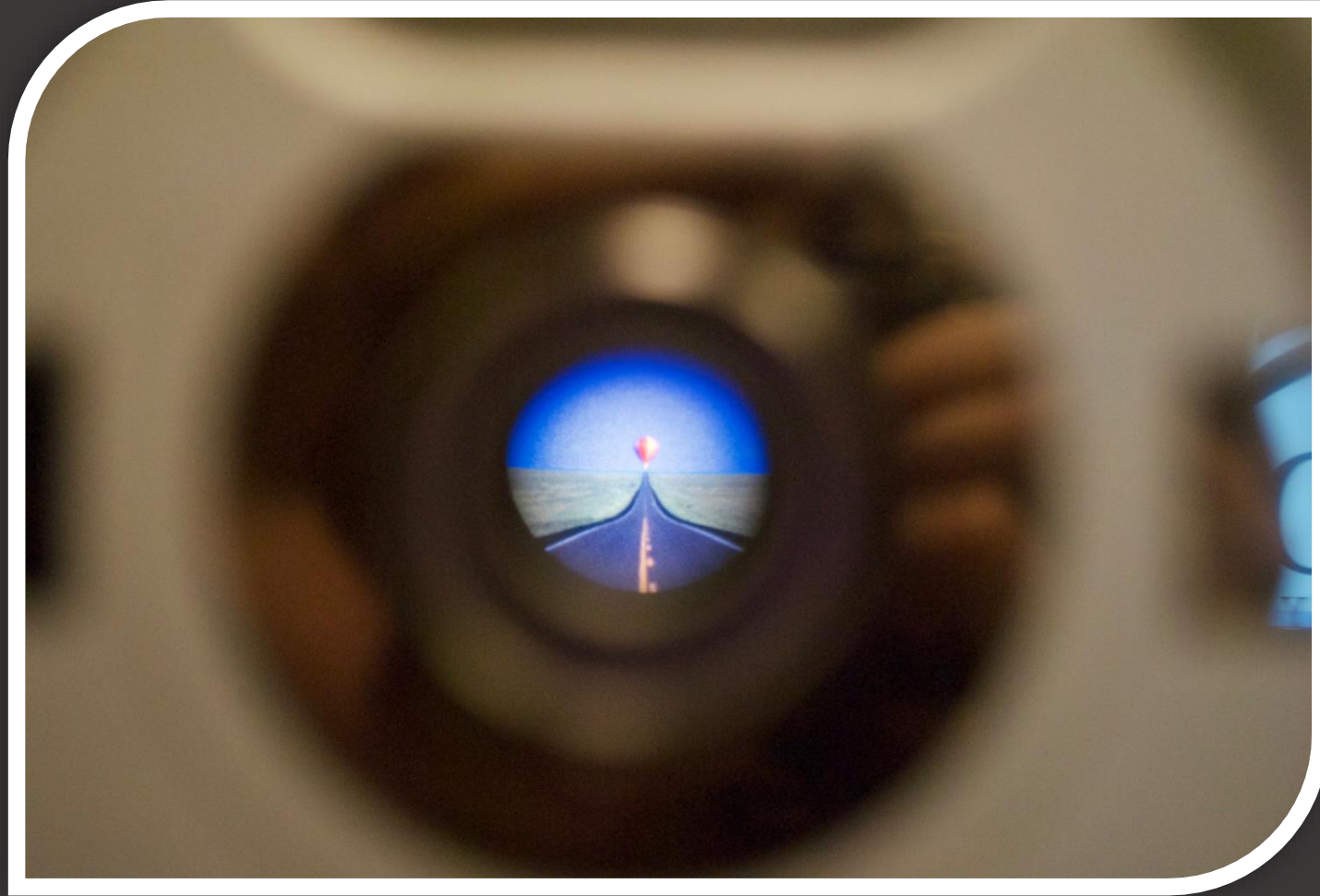
An optician

Say Cheese!

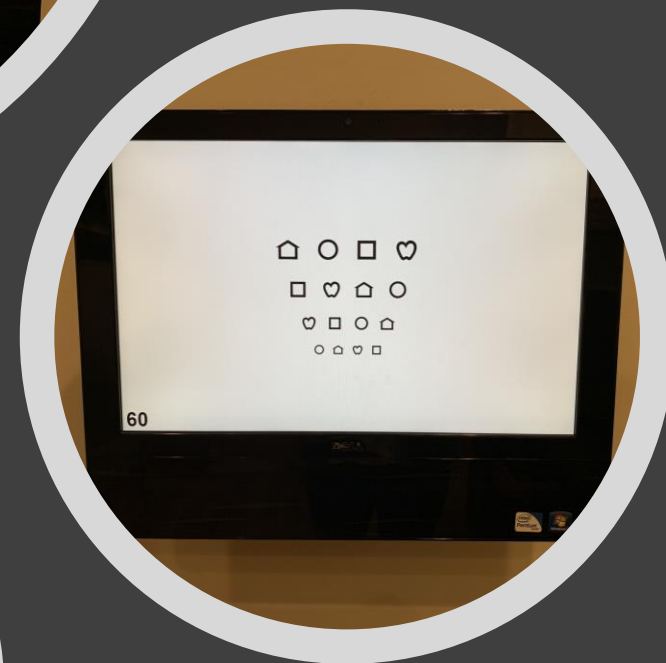


You will also have a staring contest with a tiny hot air balloon!

While you watch
the movie the doctor

flashlights



These flashlights will tell us if you need glasses and if your eyes are healthy



Tip: Our doctors won't give you any shots!

Next the doctor may use
drops or a special spray to
make your pupils bigger

Then we can look inside
your eyes

Tip: Bring your sunglasses!

This part of the exam can make your close vision a little blurry
and make you sensitive to sunlight for a few hours





It will take a few minutes for the drops to start working so you can wait in the kids area or look at glasses if the doctor says you need them



The doctor is ready to
finish your exam!

They wear a silly
flashlight hat that
helps them look into
your eyes

Before you leave our opticians will help you choose glasses if you need them

They will make sure they fit really well AND look great!
